## ANTICIPATING REDEMPTION

we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Romans 8:37

Strange things are happening in our day. It is reported that several hundred dead birds fell from the sky in Texas; thousands of birds fell from the sky in central Arkansas; 500 birds fell from the sky in Louisiana and hundreds more in Kentucky. Two million fish have washed ashore in the Chesapeake Bay area; 100,000 fish are dead in the Arkansas River and tons of fish are dead in the waters of Argentina. Ten thousand antelope lie dead in Kazakhstan. The bees are dying out in unprecedented numbers. Devastating earthquakes are happening all over the world.

It appears that the prediction of Christ concerning these happenings is coming to pass rapidly. It is an exciting time to live, knowing that Christians will soon be "raptured" into the presence of our Precious Lord.

It is also implied that these last days will find Christians the target of Satan and the forces of evil. We are told to "look up" for our redemption is drawing near. In studying II Thessalonians 1, I was impressed with

several interesting truths. Paul is thanking God for the faith of the believers at Thessalonica, and for their love, which is "growing exceedingly" (verse 3). Paul boasts of their commitment to Christ in verse 4, and their patience and faith in all their persecutions and tribulations that they are enduring. He speaks of this state as evidence of the righteous judgment of God. These thoughts suggest that persecution and suffering will precede the Lord's Second Return.

**We ought and indeed are obligated [as those in debt] to give thanks always to God for you, brethren, as is fitting, because your faith is growing exceedingly and the love of every one of you each toward the others is increasing and abounds. And this is a cause of our mentioning you with pride among the churches (assemblies) of God for your steadfastness (your unflinching endurance and patience) and your firm faith in the midst of all the persecutions and crushing distresses and afflictions under which you are holding up.**

Satan would try to discourage us, to stop us, to question our faith, bring up our past, or try to scare us. I have discovered through our deliverance sessions that Satan is scared of the Christian who is bold and fearless in his commitment to Christ. I would remind you that "greater is He (the Holy Spirit) who is in you, than Satan, who is in the sinner." The only weapons that Satan has are lies, deceptions and circumstances. Colossians 2:15 declares that all demons are disarmed, stripped of their weapons. Satan is literally scared of a Spirit filled Christian. Suffering, persecution and threats of the loss of life, money, job, reputation, etc. are tools he may use to discourage or deceive. But, if God is for us who can be against us.

**God stripped the spiritual rulers and powers of their authority. With the cross, he won the victory and showed the world that they were powerless. Colossians 2:15 NCV**

Satan uses people, circumstances, and thoughts to attack us. Satan will retreat when confronted by the power of Christ, the Word of God, the presence of the Holy Spirit. Don't look at the severity of the attack, the outward

threats or believe any of Satan's lies. Recognize that Christ is really in charge of two universes – heaven and earth – and He can employ angels and divine judgment.

When the Israelite army was threatened by Goliath's presence, they trembled for over a month—40 days, twice a day. But when the man of faith, David, saw the loud mouth opponent he reasoned, "I never saw such a big target; I can't miss". He saw God as bigger than the circumstance. He went forth, never doubting that God would direct that stone to destroy the enemy. David did not see a great problem but the solution to the problem. Is any enemy or problem bigger than God's power and provision through Christ Jesus? If so, we need a better god. God is all-powerful, King over all Kings, Ruler over all creation. Beloved, He is your Father who invested His Highest possession, Jesus Christ, to save and keep you.

Second Thessalonians 1:7-8 speaks of Christ being revealed from heaven, with His mighty angels coming in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God (atheists), as well as those who reject the gospel of Jesus Christ. What amazing words! Scripture then declares these will be punished with everlasting destruction from the pres-

ence of the Lord and the glory of His power (verse 9). Amen and amen!

**... it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you, and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power...**

## T E S T I M O N Y !

Ever since I can remember (at least 50 years), I have always felt bound, depressed, and totally inferior and inadequate when around people. As a child I was always that kid that was picked last for teams in gym, and never really excelled in anything until I started playing the trumpet. Even though I excelled in music, I was always scared to be public with my opinions, or ask questions. When I needed to read or speak publicly, I usually was shaking so much you could hear my voice quiver. This was due to much abusive experience as a child growing up, and always feeling like the “black sheep” of the family.

By the time I got married in 1979, I had learned to cover or avoid my feelings of inferiority. By the time I reached my mid 40’s I had become hostile, verbally abusive to my family, and had a severe anger management problem. I was constantly depressed, and seemingly getting more depressed with each passing day. By 50, I had been seen by several Christian councilors, and by 56, had spent 6 days in the partial admission program for behavior disorders. Though somewhat helpful, none of the directions I went permanently solved my problems.

My wife and I had led numerous groups through the home study Marriage Ministries, and I had become internationally known for the ability God had anointed me with to play the shofar, and was in great demand by major worship

leaders world wide. The truth however was that from all observances of me, a fine upstanding “man of God”, I appeared to be whole and strong in the LORD. I was not.

By August 2010, I had a growing ministry, and people seeking me for prayer for healings. God had chosen to heal numerous people and animals from cancer and blindness through the sounding of the shofar.

What I could not see was the demonic attachments that had been “hanging” on me for many years. Demons of fear, inferiority, lying, lust, unforgiveness, bitterness, and many more were all actively working in my life. The more blessings the LORD poured on me, the more demons seemed to attach themselves to me. My world all came crashing down when I became involved, through ministry, in an emotional affair with a high school sweetheart. We met every day by phone to talk and pray together. Satan was: “bringing me down”, and I could not even see it. On November 11, 2010, my wife intercepted some text messages between my “friend” and me. My wife threatened to leave, and I spent 5 nights in a hotel. Things just kept getting worse. Then I confessed my sin in writing to numerous people in ministry. My honesty may have destroyed the ministry, my deception, may have destroyed the anointing and my marriage.

A friend from church then suggested that I meet with Reverend Herritt. After a brief phone introduction, Pastor, my wife, and I met on January 24, 2011. I encouraged

my wife to go with me. I am so thankful and Praise God that she went with me.

We met and Pastor explained to us the way that demons operate in our lives. There was no theatrics or drama. Just plain old quoting of scripture and taking authority by the name, blood, and power of the Lord Jesus Christ. After a total of about 5 hours Pastor Herritt, by the power of Jesus, had led me out of bondage. He released about 41 different demons that had attached themselves to me over the past 56 years. Through confession and repentance Jesus has removed a ton of guilt, turmoil, and depression that I have carried since birth, perhaps even pre-birth. Suddenly I felt free and energetic. For the first time in many years, I cared about everything, and I was light and zealous about living.

The past two weeks have been the best two weeks of my life, as well as my marriage. My wife has asked me several times “Who *are* you?”

Through the guidance and blessing of this ministry, I have been given a new life. All I can say is “Praise God! I am a new man in Christ full of confidence, speaking the truth, and enjoying where God is taking me. Thank you Pastor Herritt for being obedient to the LORD and following the call He has put on your life. Shalom, DH ♦
